- 5:00pm** In stadium READY to go!
Band practice on game field w/ cheerleaders, dance team and band-
Band dress= Member shirt, Marching shoes, Blue Jeans, Black Socks, Gloves for hornline, Hair pulled back, No hats, No sunglasses, NO jewelry. Yes, clean polished instrument.
- Percussion remember to bring your stands to the bleachers BEFORE 5:00. Pit all equipment needs to be behind the band bleachers by 6:00. Including carts and gator.
- 5:30pm** Troop back to PAC area and warm-up in sections.
- 5:30pm** Gates Open- Band parents are not allowed to go into the stadium to reserve seats before 5:30; even if you are volunteering with the band. Please wait until 5:30 to find your spots.
- 5:40pm** Field available for warm-up (both football teams)
- 6:15pm** Band marches down runway and onto track in front of home bleachers and then to visiting team's sideline on track
- 6:25pm** Football, Cheer and Dancers Senior Night Recognition on the track.
- 6:35pm** Both teams must be off field for band pre-game performance
- 6:40pm** **Band pre-game performance on field**
(Dance Team Will performs prior to band entrance onto the field.)
- Fight Song
 - Presentation of the colors by ROTC
 - National Anthem sung by choir soloist in the press box
 - Choir sings- Alma Mater
 - Fight Song
 - Form Tunnel
 - All Groups fight song again
 - March to bleachers under score board from Visitor Side
- 6:50pm** Teams enter field – approximately 7:50 p.m.
- 6:53pm** South next through band tunnel at north end of stadium
- 7:00pm** Game time – kick-off
HALFTIME -15 minutes normal length
Marching Band performance is first- marching and playing with the met the opener through the transition.
- 9:30pm** **Approx pick-up time for band-** Parents the band will troop back to the school from the stadium as a group. We will then circle up in the gym and do our final announcements. We ask that the parents wait for the members outside so they can get in and out of the band room and school faster.

Things to remember:

- Pick up and drop off on the PAC side of the building. This should help with the congestion. No one will be able to park or enter from the South side of the building.
- Students that are driving are asked to carpool. All students driving must be in the lot by 4:15.
- Member attire for this game is -Blue Jeans (with no holes and must fit you. Wear a belt!) Member shirt tucked in, Black socks, Black marching shoes, Black Gloves for hornline, Hair pulled back if needed, everyone should comb your hair (look good), No jewelry(this is a state activity rule), Yes you need your instrument. Make sure it is clean and polished prior to 5:00pm.
- You will not be able to go sit with your parents or non band friends during the game. We sit as a band for the entire game. Our job is to create a positive atmosphere during the game and cheer the football team onto victory! After the game we will troop back to the school as a unit and dismiss after all the uniforms and equipment are put away. As always we would love for as many parents to help.
