TBA Finals warm-up and performance time

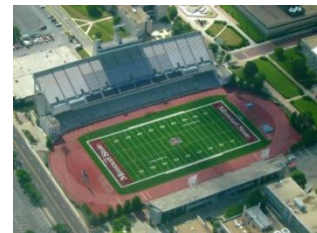
