On December 12, 2011 we have our first holiday concert of the year. Below is the concert attire portion of the handbook. Please look over the information so you can purchase the needed items as early as possible. Student report time will be 6:00pm in your seats ready to go on stage. The concert will begin at 7:00pm. Admission is one can good per person. All donated items will be given to a local family shelter for the holidays.

### **Concert Band Attire**

An audience experiences a concert on many different levels, not all of which are strictly musical. It is an undeniable fact, for instance that the appearance of a performing group has a significant impact on the audience's perception of that group. To establish the uniqueness of performing experiences, the following concert dress guidelines have been established.

#### **Ladies**

Symphonic Band members will have uniforms issued by the school. In addition female member need to provide the following items:

- Black hose
- Black closed-toe dress shoes (avoid high heels)
- Professional hair- pulled back away from your face

Freshmen Center Female Members need to wear the following items:

- Black pants or long black skirt
- White long sleeved blouse with collar
- Black hose
- Black closed-toe dress shoes (avoid high heels)
- Professional hair- pulled back away from your face

#### **Men**

***All sophomore and any additional junior or senior males that ordered a tux shirt please remember you will need to pay for the tux shirt before you can receive it. Shirts cost \$15 and they are yours to keep. Shirts should be in at the start of the week of December 5<sup>th</sup>. Cash or check is fine. Make checks out to BSS Band. You will need this shirt for the performance on Monday and throughout the rest of the year.***
